## Solidarity Statement on the 80th Anniversary of the Nuclear Bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki

To the working class masses in Palestine and around the world, To the free people of the labor and trade union movement,

To our comrades and friends in Japan, and in the progressive ZENKO labor rganization,

In these days, with hearts gripped by pain and minds filled with determination for human dignity, we commemorate the 80th anniversary of the nuclear bombings committed by the United States of America against the Japanese people in the cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki in 1945 — when nuclear bombs turned thousands of bodies into ash, destroyed cities and life itself, and opened the door to a dangerous nuclear age that threatens all of humanity.

We, in the Palestinian Workers Struggle Union, express our deep solidarity with the brave people of Japan and with the Japanese labor and trade union movement, which has, over the past decades, preserved its free voice advocating for peace, justice, and nuclear disarmament. We extend a special salute to our comrades and friends in the ZENKO labor organization in Japan, who have never hesitated to express their steadfast support for the struggle of our Palestinian people for freedom, justice, and an end to occupation, and who have taken an honorable stance against all forms of oppression, colonialism, and discrimination.
